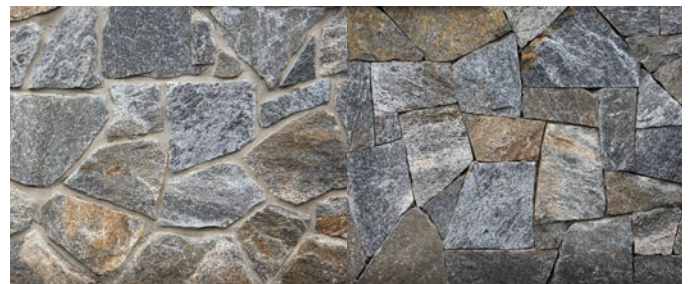
Installation Tips
